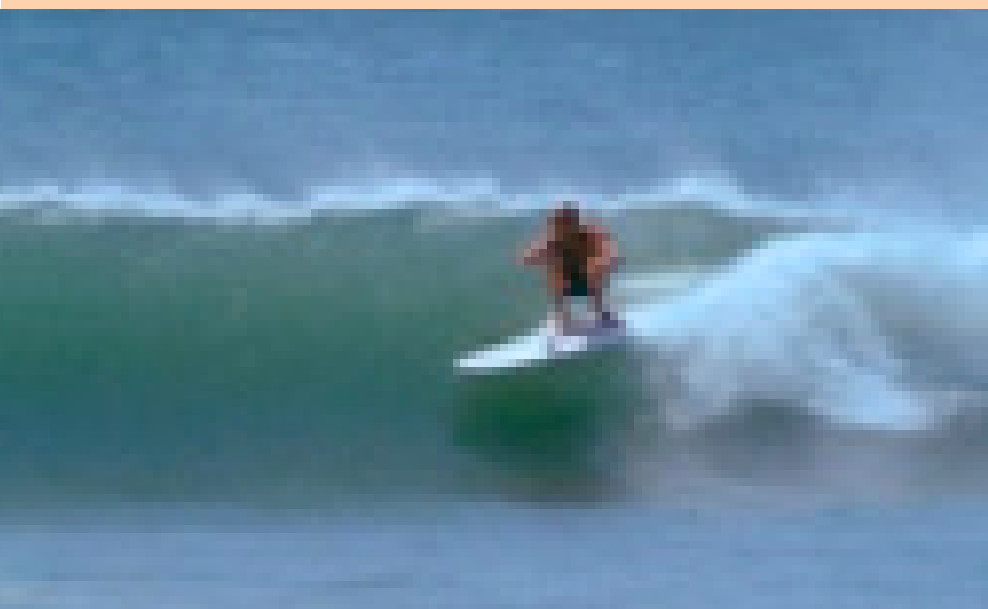
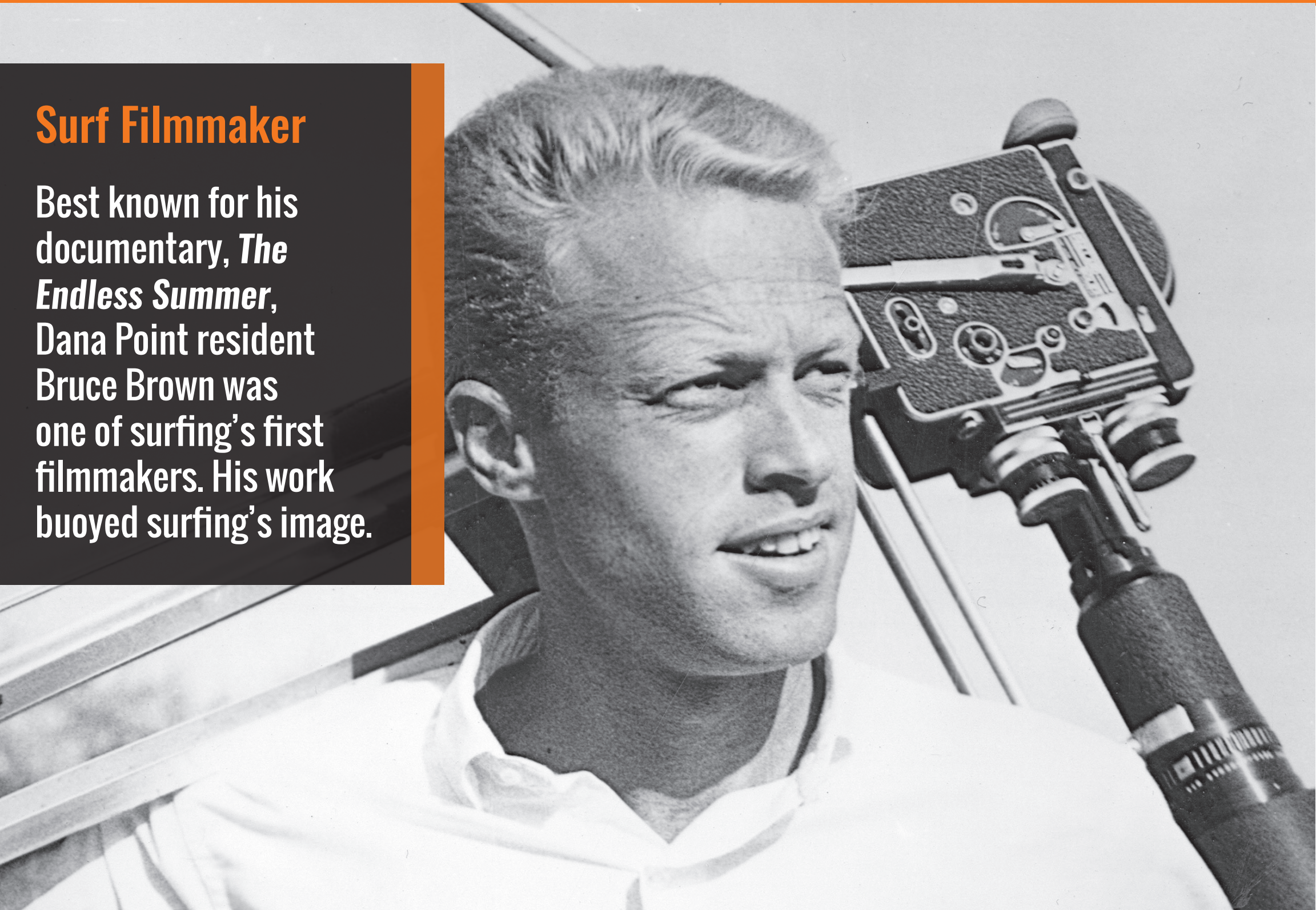

# BRUCE BROWN (1937-2018)

## Surf Filmmaker

Best known for his documentary, *The Endless Summer*, Dana Point resident Bruce Brown was one of surfing's first filmmakers. His work buoyed surfing's image.
